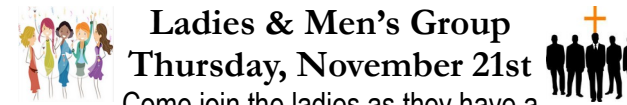
Community Thanksgiving Worship Service - Wednesday, Nov. 20th @ 7PM

Pearl River Feeding Ministry

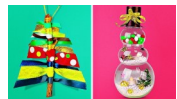
